




# MEMBERSHIPS FOR MILITARY FAMILIES

### WHAT IS MISSION YOUTH **OUTREACH?**

The MISSION: Youth Outreach partnership supports kids and teens, ages 6 to 18, by creating a positive, supportive network. Through this partnership, dependent youth of active-duty, National Guard and Reserve families are eligible to receive a free annual membership or summer camp experience with a Boys & Girls Club. (Additional membership, transportation, summer camp and/or field trip fees may apply at some locations.)

## WHAT DOES A **BOYS & GIRLS CLUB** OFFER?

Boys & Girls Clubs offer a wide variety of educational, recreational, cultural and social activities for kids and teens. Clubs are designed to maximize opportunities for young people to acquire a sense of belonging, usefulness, influence and competence. A typical Club has an arts and crafts area, gymnasium, computer lab, games room and multi-purpose rooms. Some Clubs have swimming pools, a learning center, camps and outdoor play areas. All Boys & Girls Clubs are staffed by trained, caring professionals who inspire young people to reach their full potential.
